

## SECTION 11 - EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

### Emergency Preparedness Policy

The purpose of Emergency Response Planning is to provide a mechanism by which management can formulate control procedures and arrange for any required emergency resources.

The following procedures are designed to permit a smooth response in the event a situation develops into an emergency requiring EMS (fire, ambulance, and police), environmental services, rescue, etc.

### Emergency Classifications

- ✓ Fire & Explosions
- ✓ Medical emergency/fatality
- ✓ Chemical Spills & Leaks
- ✓ Vehicle Accidents
- ✓ Criminal Acts
- ✓ Acts of Terrorism
- ✓ Natural Disaster Emergencies
- ✓ Pandemic
- ✓ Data Breach

### Documentation

Regardless of the nature and extent of an emergency, all events and actions must be well documented for subsequent investigation and follow-up (i.e. - statements, photos, diagrams pertaining to the emergency, etc.).

### Corporate Emergency Response Team

The following describes a Corporate Emergency Response Team by position and responsibility:

General Manager	Shaw representative responsible for all activities in the operational area and providing information to the CEO/President of The Shaw Group Limited. Shaw representative responsible for coordination of the emergency.
Health & Safety	Shaw representative responsible for advising operations personnel on Health & Safety matters.
Public Affairs	Shaw representative responsible for preparation of public reports for release to media by the CEO or designee.
Environmental	Shaw representative responsible for advising personnel on all Environmental matters.
